I understand that Mr Harry Sou has been in contact with regard to possible meeting with Treasurer (Curtis Pitt MP) Just by way of some background to the discussion:

- Mr Ken Lee^{Contrary to Public Interest}
- his associations with FNQ and Cairns go back over 10 years
- The property totals 626.65 Hectares (approximately 1,548.49 Acres) over 12 titles with access from Barnwell Road Myola
- The land has been improved by slashing all the grassed areas and in early 2015 through clearing works (nonremnant) over the past 12 month
- About 1/3 of the total property would be easily categorised as "developable" given vegetation and topography constraints (around 220 Ha including watercourses)
- The remaining 2/3 is vegetated but is also an asset to the land providing activities and nature based tourism options

In October, Mr Lee saw opportunity to build upon the increasing connections between ASE Asia and China with FNQ tourism and develop a reasonable clear vision for the land to incorporate:
